Palatal/Lingual Appliance

Your palatal/lingual arch appliance has been fitted today

This has been glued around your first molar teeth and is designed to hold your back teeth in this position before you have some teeth extracted.

You may experience some discomfort for the first few weeks, and speech may be affected for a couple of days. The shape of the appliance may appear on your tongue and this may also be temporarily uncomfortable.

It is important to keep this appliance clean at all times. Avoid very sticky and chewy food and also food which is very hard as this will damage the appliance and may cause the glue seal to break.

It is important to brush your teeth and the appliance after every meal. You will have been shown how to use the patient relief wax - so keep this with you in case it is required.

You must continue to see your regular dentist for check-up appointments throughout your orthodontic treatment.

It is essential to keep all your appointments at the practice. Patients who fail to co-operate, maintain good oral hygiene or fail to attend regularly may have their treatment stopped.
